 at the Races were paid from cash collected at the event, which is acceptable as long as it is
 written down and witnessed.

 - also considering reviving trail behind the soccer field. The trails is from a boy scout project several years ago and Boosters would like to recover it.

Principal's Report – Mr Martin

- Finished science fair, grades 5-8. Mrs Schous did a nice job, and we see lots of opportunity for cross-curriculum, will continue to look into those possibilities in the future
- MAP is finished as of tomorrow
- Catholic Schools week has been exciting, Mr Martin thanked PTO and parents for food that was brought in for teachers today
- A committee met to discuss '24-'25 academic calendar, made some adjustments accounting for parent feedback, looks like first day of school may be later than normal (still needs to be confirmed by committee – dates will be announced soon)
 - also discussed possibility of extending school day by 10 minutes to reduce total number of school days we need in the year, this would also make it possible to take Mon & Tues off for thanksgiving to give traveling families a whole week off.

- Parent teacher conferences: committee is discussing adjusting both time of year and style to better serve parents and students based on parent and teacher feedback.
- Lastly, discussing shifting away from iPads for 5-8 for Chromebooks because students should have devices with keyboards. 5th graders would receive a Chromebook and it would be theirs until 8th grade. Students will be able to take home to do assignments – however this would require increasing registration fee to cover costs.
