- The back-to-school popcorn gift totaled \$271.89. This was taken from Family Enrichment, but a new line will be added to the budget to account for this expense.

- Soccer signups ended on Friday, 3/12 with 75 children participating.
- Mary is coordinating the coaches for soccer.
- Porta potties for the soccer field are being delivered on Thursday, 3/18.

- Sharon is applying for a girls basketball uniform grant from the Diocese.

- The school has had very few Covid cases.
- Mr. Gannon is thankful to the faculty and parents for keeping everyone healthy.
